Profile of 2018-2019 School Year

Tuition: In the 2018-2019 School Year, our Kindergarten did not join the "Free Quality Kindergarten Education". After approval by the "Education Bureau", the annual (2018-2019) monthly tuition is \$3970. (The annual tuition fee received a total of 10, every year in September to next June).

Miscellaneous fees: The following school items & services, parents may choose from the Kindergarten or to buy on their own, but the style must comply with the standards of the Kindergarten.

School uniform: Summer approximately \$345 Winter approximately \$754

Books: approximate \$1,100 for each semester Snacks fee: approximate \$500 for each semester (Books, miscellaneous fees and snacks fee are paid separately for each semester.)

K1: Children born from 1st October, 2015 to 31st December, 2016 can apply.

Teachers' Qualification

All kindergarten teachers (including principals) have completed Qualified Kindergarten Teacher. 3% of teachers hold a Master's Degree in Education and 89% hold a Bachelor's Degree in Kindergarten Education. 34% of teachers hold a valid First Aid certificate.

Educational Psychology Service

Since 1994, Catholic Diocesan Hong Kong has engaged educational psychologists to provide services to its schools and to extend its services to kindergartens from 2011 onwards to cater for the individual differences of young children and to promote the whole person development. Services include students, teacher-training and parent education.

School Characteristics

In order to promote the overall development of Raimondi College Kindergarten Section, the curriculum focuses on "child-centredness", and to attain all-round development in the domains of spirit, ethics, intellect, physique, social skills and aesthetics. Through "Love Education and Life Education", to promote children's understanding of God, love and service, and to cultivate children's healthy growth, exploration, good biliteracy and trilingualism, creativity and problem-solving skills.

Our students will be given priority for entry into Raimondi College Primary Section. In addition, they will be assessed on the basis of their moral character, self-care ability and language development.

Since the 2015-2016 school year, we have provided a school-nurse and a school counselor to care for our children's physical and mental health.

Universal Mission

Our College shares the universal mission and the 5 Core Values: Truth, Justice, Love, Life and Family, of Catholic Schools to provide Whole Person Education based on our school motto, "In Constantia Fortitudo" (Keep practicing with perseverance). We shall guide our students to persevere in their quest for knowledge and help students build their character, develop their potential and their sense of commitment towards the community at large. It is the school's hope that all students and members of staff experience the spirit of love and understand the teachings of the Gospel both through the curriculum and school life.

School curriculum

The curriculum is designed and implemented according to the stages, characteristics and the needs of student's physical and mental development. Learning diversification includes integration courses such as the thematic and the project-based approaches, through various teaching strategies and methods, such as environmental exploration, physical manipulation, games, experience sharing, sensory problem-solving, inquiry and other interactive learning. as a class, in groups, as individuals and other learning forms, to inspire children to think and develop their potential.

At the same time, our English teachers and Mandarin teachers will create an enriched learning environment which definitely boost student's interest in learning languages and enhance their listening and speaking skills.

School Facilities

The school has nine classrooms, a multi-function room, multi-intelligence room, Music room, Hall and large outdoor venues to provide sufficient learning space for students. There are interactive electronic whiteboards, laptops, online learning platform and audio-visual teaching materials to enhance student's learning interest and efficiency.
