

Any requests for re-scheduling will not be considered. If the applicant fails to attend the interview, the application will be waived.

Profile of 2024-2025School Year

Tuition: In the 2024-2025 School Year, our Kindergarten did not join the "Free Quality Kindergarten Education". After approval by the "Education Bureau", the annual (2024-2025) monthly tuition is \$4,080. (The annual tuition fee received a total of 10, every year in September to next June).

Miscellaneous fees: The following school items & services, parents may choose from the Kindergarten or to buy on their own, but the style must comply with the standards of the Kindergarten.

School uniform: Summer approximately \$340 Winter approximately \$750

Books: 1st term approximately \$900 2nd term approximately \$700
